


How to Support Fishes & Loaves Food Pantry

Faith Tabernacle Church, located at 2422 West Patapsco Avenue, is one of the oldest multicultural churches in the southwest Baltimore community. This community has a large population that lives below the federal poverty line. The risk factors which impact this population are economical and social deprivation due to a lack of employment and employment opportunities.

A large percentage of the households in this community are run by one working adult. Faith Tabernacle has reached out to the neighborhood to instill and restore hope while providing much needed resources.

Following the biblical principle that you are your brother's keeper, Faith Tabernacle embraces the slogan, *"Have a heart, lend a hand"* to help feed the needy during these economically challenging times.

Through the slogan *"Have a heart, lend a hand"*, Faith Tabernacle has opened its doors to the **Fishes & Loaves Food Pantry**. Most pantries offer food and clothing only, but Fishes & Loaves is a little more unique.

Fishes & Loaves Pantry not only offers frozen and non-perishable food, but we also offer household goods, toiletries, health and beauty aids, and infant/toddler items.

The pantry partners with the Department of Social Services to provide clients in the southwest Baltimore community with emergency food.

Our goal is to collaborate with other organizations to be a resource and to lend a hand to everyone who needs it in this region, so that no one ever goes hungry or suffers for lack of proper resources.

Our policy at Fishes & Loaves Food Pantry is to serve all of our clients with equal quality and respect. To ensure this, we have developed simple guidelines. We serve everyone a maximum of twice a month when they need it. People who come with or without a DSS voucher are eligible to receive any items that we have.
